Practicums will be scheduled alongside your regular class timings and may start as early as 2 months after course commencement, depending on the schedule you choose. Successful applicants will need to secure placement at eligible early childhood development centres (kindergartens or childcare centres).

If you have a degree or a locally recognised diploma and have obtained a GCE O-level credit in English (EL1), you may apply for the Diploma (Conversion) in Early Childhood Care & Education - Teaching course, where you can graduate in 9 or 13 months, depending on the course schedule you choose.*

... you can be sponsored during your training and work at the same time?

With the Place-and-Train programme, you can be sponsored for your training and receive a monthly salary during your course.* To qualify, you will need to secure employment with an ECDA-licensed early childhood

development centre. The fulfilment of your bond will depend on the centre's terms and conditions. Find out more here. Click here for more information.
